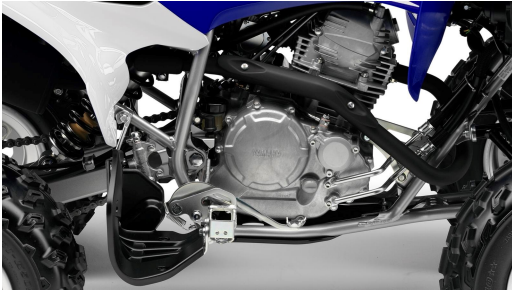

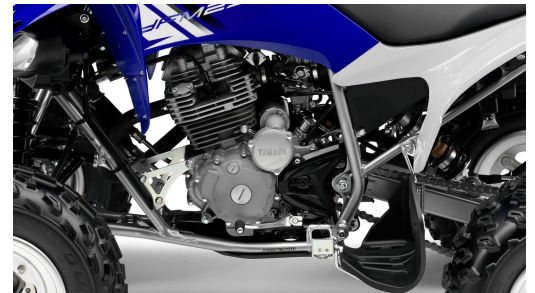


### Punchy 249cc 4-stroke engine

The light and powerful air-cooled 249cc 4-stroke engine produces a broad, deep powerband and starts with a push of a button. Its special low-friction ceramic-coated cylinder ensures reduced wear and excellent heat dissipation.

### Smooth transmission

The five-speed manual transmission provides the flexibility to tackle almost any trail, while the 29mm carburetor provides light throttle pull and excellent throttle response across the entire rpm range.



### Advanced chassis

The light, strong and short-wheelbase chassis ensures excellent comfort levels and super responsive, high-performance handling.

### Suspension geometry

The independent double-wishbone front suspension, with five-way preload-adjustable shocks, provides plenty of travel.



### Balanced rims and calipers

Lightweight aluminium rims and front brake calipers reduce unsprung weight for excellent suspension performance, acceleration, deceleration and handling.

### Aggressive styling

Distinctive R-line bodywork and headlights combine with a fresh graphical look to present an impressive presence on the trail.

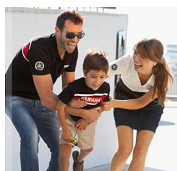

ATVs with engines of 70 to 90cc are recommended only for use by riders 12 years and older, and always under adult supervision. ATVs with engines of 90cc or greater are recommended for use only by riders 16 years and older. ATVs are built to operate within their design limits. Safe towable weights, together with maximum carrying capacity are identified in the owner's manual if applicable. For durability, reliability, but most important of all, operator safety, under no circumstances should the recommended capacities be exceeded. Yamaha recommends that all ATV riders take an approved training course. For safety and training information, see your dealer or call your Yamaha Distributor in your country. ATVs can be hazardous to operate. For your safety: always avoid paved surfaces. ATVs are designed for unpaved surfaces only. Riding on paved surfaces may seriously affect handling and control and can cause loss of control. Always wear a helmet, eye protection and protective clothing. Never carry any passengers. Never engage in stunt riding. Riding and alcohol/drugs don't mix. Avoid excessive speed and be particularly careful on difficult terrain. Please 'tread lightly': always ride in a responsible manner, respecting the environment as well as country and local laws. The riders in this brochure are professionals: don't attempt to emulate them. The specification and appearance of Yamaha products will be varied from time to time without notice, and as shown here are illustrative only and are not a contractual description of products. Some models are shown with optional accessories. All ATVs come with a 12-month Limited Factory Warranty, except for Banshee, which carries a 90-day Limited Factory Warranty.
