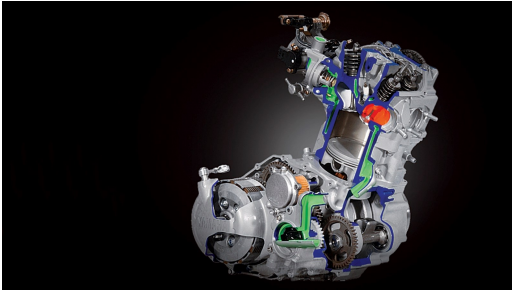

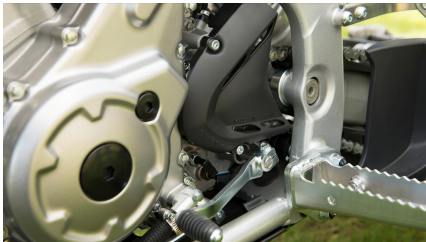


Precision engine design

Unlike some ATVs, Yamaha 4-stroke ATV engines provide high levels of torque even at low rpm. The result is terrain-hugging traction, even in difficult conditions. For maximum power and economy, the Electronic Fuel Injection system optimises the fuel/air mix in the combustion chamber. Plus, new components in the big end and gearbox enhance durability.

Extra-strong hybrid chassis

For the kind of strength that withstands every knock and bump, a state-of-the-art chassis combines a steel front section with an aluminium rear section and detachable subframe. A new additional gusset offers extra rigidity, and increased powder coating protects against scratches and chips.



Effortless transmission

The YFM700R has a 5-speed gearbox (with reverse). For total confidence when exploring this ATV's powerful 686cc engine, gear selection makes for rapid, smooth transmission.

Adjustable suspension

To aid riders graduating to the YFM700R, the suspension system uses factory-set spring preload-adjustable gas front shocks and piggyback gas rear shocks. This delivers a more friendly ride, reduced body roll and confidence-inspiring rider feedback. The adjustable spring preload lets you fine-tune suspension to suit your riding style and conditions.



Finely balanced rims and callipers

Lightweight rims and brake callipers contribute to a low unsprung weight. Two-piston front brake callipers ensure great stopping power while the new two-piston rear brake callipers design, also already used on our sports YFZ450R, give more braking power. Both providing the rider with better feedback.

Ergonomic design

Piloting an ATV is a fun, physical activity that uses unusual combinations of muscles. Yamaha ATVs are designed to be straightforward to use, and comfortable for the widest possible range of body shapes and sizes. The front end redesign allows for extra knee clearance for improved body movement, while retaining the aggressive, streamlined YFM700R styling.

ATVs with engines up to 70cc are recommended for use only by riders 6 years and older and always with adult supervision. ATVs with engines of 70 to 90cc are recommended only for use by riders 12 years and older, and always under adult supervision. ATVs with engines of 90cc or greater are recommended for use only by riders 16 years and older. ATVs are built to operate within their design limits. Safe towable weights, together with maximum carrying capacity are identified in the owner's manual if applicable. For durability, reliability, but most important of all, operator safety, under no circumstances should the recommended capacities be exceeded. Yamaha recommends that all ATV riders take an approved training course. For safety and training information, see your dealer or call your Yamaha Distributor in your country. ATVs can be hazardous to operate. For your safety: always avoid paved surfaces. ATVs are designed for unpaved surfaces only. Riding on paved surfaces may seriously affect handling and control and can cause loss of control. Always wear a helmet, eye protection and protective clothing. Never carry any passengers. Never engage in stunt riding. Riding and alcohol/drugs don't mix. Avoid excessive speed and be particularly careful on difficult terrain. Please 'tread lightly': always ride in a responsible manner, respecting the environment as well as country and local laws. The riders in this brochure are professionals: don't attempt to emulate them. The specification and appearance of Yamaha products will be varied from time to time without notice, and as shown here are illustrative only and are not a contractual description of products. Some models are shown with optional accessories. All ATVs come with a 12-month Limited Factory Warranty, except for Banshee, which carries a 90-day Limited Factory Warranty. 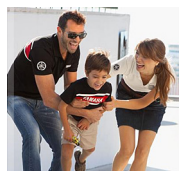
